These groups may use a portion of the contributions for political activities. Their efforts in this regard are subject to reporting requirements under federal and state laws. The Company receives information from trade associations regarding the portion of our dues or contributions that are used for lobbying or political purposes. Below is a list of trade and business associations to which the Company contributed in 2021 that have advised us that a portion of our dues and other payments were used for lobbying or political expenditures and such amounts that were used for lobbying expenses or political expenditures are reported below:
